Rules Violated:

- 315.33 FAILURE TO PERFORM DUTIES OF GREYHOUND PADDOCK JUDGE
- 315.5 FAILURE TO EXERCISE DUE DILIGENCE IN PERFORMING OFFICIAL DUTIES/TO REP

Paddock Judge Tameshia Brown having been duly noticed waived her right to a formal hearing and entered into an agreed settlement the Gulf Greyhound Park Board of Judges on 12/20/2014. Ms. Brown is hereby issued a written warning. On 12/13/2014 Ms. Brown allowed greyhound 9-8 CTW OH NO TIGGER to race with a pair of latex gloves under its blanket. The gloves were put there by a leadout while in the holding area so that another leadout could use the gloves to walk the greyhound who had been cleaned up after messing his crate. One of the duties of the Paddock Judge is to inspect the blankets for fit. A good inspection of the blanket may have found the gloves. During the race the gloves fell onto the track but did not cause any incident in the race and the race was called official. This is the first violation of this rule for Ms. Brown.
